
Total Knee Replacement



RECOVERY PROGRESSION

- Outpatient surgery (80% go home the same day) or stay overnight
- Surgery time = 2 hours
- Activity- Crutches or walker for balance. No brace. No motion or weight bearing restrictions.
- Physical Therapy -Starts immediately after surgery
 - Outpatient PT 1-2x week for approximately 3 months
- Restrictions-
 - Return to Office Work- 1-2 weeks
 - Doing most activities of daily living and most work 4-6 weeks
 - Full range of motion and begin strengthening and sport 3 months
 - Full activities 4-6 months
- Postoperative Visits-
 - 2 weeks- staples out and review surgery and xrays
 - o 6 weeks- check range of motion
 - o 3 months- ensure full range of motion and normal walking
 - 4-6 months as needed
